Dear Mr. **Fabrice Leggeri**,

Italian's State Police introduced a reorganisation project of their own offices, that includes the closure of 4 Maritime border police offices (Savona, La Spezia, Gioia Tauro and Messina), reducing the operating staff of these offices and handing the border duties to the local Police Headquarters.

In this way the competence learned in Frontier and also in Maritime Security will be lost, and the ability of supervision and inspection of the sensitive areas, like sea ports with high flow of passengers are, would be severely reduced.

This State Police's Trade Union ask for your help in order to spend some words on behalf of these Frontier Post with the government bodies that you consider appropriate, before the 05th December 2014, to point out and underline the big mistake of this project, that is the reduction, at the present international context, of the staff of the external borders belonging to the Schengen Area.
